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La Brouette Rose, Producers Plaimont, NV £12.99  
*French regional Roses should be fresh, fruity and have a touch of dryness  
And here we have it!*

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Domaine de Montauberon Rose, 2008 £13.99  
*Pale pink and produced at a fine property beside the Mediterranean near Agde.  
The vintage was marvellous for this dry, clean rose*

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Chardonnay D'oc Patriarche 2007 £12.99  
*A fruity nose evoking yellow fruits with an aroma of vanilla*

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Sauvignon Cotes du Duras Berticot 2008/9 £12.99  
*A classic dry Sauvignon from the Southwest of France, which is soft and easy to drink.*

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Viognier V.D.P. du Gard Dom. Du Bahourat 2008 £14.50  
*Rich fruit flavours and full bodied with violets on the nose and a clean finish.*

Sauvignon de Touraine Dom. Roc de Chatteauvieux 2008 <i>Dry crisp finish with full fruit flavour.</i>	£14.99
Sauvignon Petit Bourgeois Corney and Barrow 2007 <i>Made by Henri Bourgeois, a highly respected Sancerre producer. This is his 'House Wine' – almost a Sancerre 'in drag'.</i>	£15.99
Sancerre 'La Clochette' Jean Jacques Breton 2006/7 <i>Dry crisp and elegant with light gooseberry fruit.</i>	£18.99
Pouilly Fume 'La Renardiere' 2008 <i>Wow, almost new world with so much fruit shining through, dry finish with typical gunflint flavours.</i>	£21.99

### BURGUNDY

Macon Solutre, 2008 <i>A family owned estate producing a clean fresh Macon.</i>	£17.50
Bourgogne Les Setilles, Olivier Leflaive, 2007 <i>Made from young Puligny-Montrachet and Meursault vines, this Chardonnay Clearly demonstrates the merits of White Burgundy. Oak aged but not for too long, it definitely doesn't dominate.</i>	£19.50
Chablis 'La Colombe' P. Boutinot 2007/8 <i>Clean fresh and dry with a long finish.</i>	£20.99

### ALSACE

Pinot Blanc Cave de Turckheim 2007 <i>Crisp and dry – good summer wine.</i>	£13.99
Gewurztraminer Cave de Turckheim 2007/8 <i>Rich spicy white excellent with chicken or oriental dishes.</i>	£16.50

Grenache/Syrah Vaucluse Champ du Moulin 2006/7 <i>Smooth easy drinking red with a ripe berry taste.</i>	£13.25
Pinot Noir V.D.P.L'Aude Le Fou 2008 <i>Up front juicy fruit with warmth and roundness.</i>	£14.50

## BORDEAUX

Corney & Barrow Claret, 2006 <i>A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc from this truly remarkable Bordeaux vintage. The wine has a beautiful, vivid and brilliant red colour with fresh and flowery Aromas of red fruit. This continues on the palate with just a touch of spice and soft Bordeaux tannins.</i>	£14.99
L'Orangerie de Carignan, 2007 <i>An excellent vintage Claret, a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. Deep colour and fruity palate to match.</i>	£17.99

## BURGUNDY

Beaujolais Villages, P Ferraud, 2007 <i>The wine comes from the vineyards of the Ferraud family in the commune of Vaux, better known under the name Clochemerle. The vineyard has good exposure and gentle slopes. The Gamay grape in this wine shows off the delicious red fruit bouquet and soft, refreshing flavours of great Beaujolais.</i>	£13.99
Fleurie La Madone Boutinot, 2008 <i>Silky and elegant, this is from the best of Fleuries's vineyards.</i>	£17.50

## RHONE

Cotes du Rhone Villages, Georges Darriaud 2007 <i>A soft light bodied red wine with a slightly spicy character.</i>	£13.50
Crozes Hermitage Tain l' Hermitage 2005/6 <i>From the top co-op in the French valley, elegant with a long finish.</i>	£21.99



## ITALIAN WHITE

Trebbiano d' Abruzzo Ancora 2007 <i>Light dry wine with a clean finish.</i>	£12.50
Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Sanvigilio 2008/9 <i>A light, crisp, dry white from Northern Italy which is eminently drinkable.</i>	£12.99
Sauvignon Blanc, La Tunella, 2008 <i>A wonderful pure Sauvignon flavour from a tiny vineyard in north-east Italy. Lots of soft fruit with just a hint of grapefruit on the finish.</i>	£14.99

## ITALIAN ROSE

Pinot Grigio Rosè Mirabello 2008 <i>Delicate strawberry flavour great summer quaffing this will enhance any party.</i>	£12.50
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## ITALIAN RED

Sangiovese di Toscana Bonnacchi 2008 <i>Surprisingly full fruity red goes well in the summer.</i>	£12.99
Masseria dei Trullari, Primitivo del Tarantino, Puglia, 2006 <i>From the heart of Italy comes this Puglia wine. The Primitivo grape gives autumnal fruit on the nose and full, ripe, soft-berried flavours on the plate. Marvellous on its own or with food.</i>	£13.25
Chianti Rufina Prunatelli 2007 <i>Clean cherry flavour with rustic notes to add a little backbone.</i>	£14.75

*A new style Rioja which is dry with good fruit content and some oak age.*

*Brilliant pink Rioja smooth and dry with a long finish.*

## SPANISH RED

Seleccionada Vega del Rayo 2007

*Aged for 8 months in barrels, voted one of the top Riojas, great value.*

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Crianza Marques de Caceres 2005

£16.50

*A delightful Rioja, the emphasis being on ageing in the bottle not in the barrel to produce a red which is both fleshy and fruity.*

*Medium dry Reisling if you like a slightly sweeter wine this is good value.*

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Piesporter Hans Rittman N.V. £12.99  
*Light fruity medium wine.*

## PORTUGUESE ROSE

Casal Mendes Caves Alianca N.V. £11.99  
*Great flavour from this surprising and attractive wine in the funny shaped bottle.*

## PORTUGUESE RED

Dao Reserva Caves Alianca 2005/6 £12.99  
*Serious dark fruits showing well with a smooth finish.*

## SOUTH AFRICAN WHITE

Chenin Blanc Paarl Heights 2009 £12.50  
*A dry, yet fruity white wine with a long crisp finish.*

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Chardonnay False Bay 2008 £12.75  
*From the Robertson district, full dry citrusy fruit.*

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Sauvignon Blanc False Bay 2009 £12.75  
*Dry herbaceous flavours with a clean finish.*

## SOUTH AFRICAN RED

Shiraz Paarl Heights 2008 £12.50  
*Some occasions call for a lighter red such as this. It has full fruit and no hard tannins.*

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Merlot Bainskloof, Breede River, 2007 £12.50  
*Not only are the wines of South Africa very popular but so is the Merlot grape - full and soft. Almost too easy to drink!*

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Pinotage False Bay 2006/8 £12.75  
*Old vines predominate in this Pinotage which is South Africa's national grape variety.*

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Cabernet Sauvignon Kushushu Creek 2008 £13.50  
*This Cabernet Sauvignon has power and weight but achieves it with only a hint of oak.*



## AUSTRALIAN WHITE

Colombard / Chardonnay Jarrah Ridge 2008 <i>Easy drinking wine with the Colombard taking the edge off the toasty Chardonnay.</i>	£12.25
Semillon Chardonnay Opal Ridge S E Australia 2008 <i>A vibrant fresh Semillon from the Griffith area with 15% Chardonnay to give it length.</i>	£12.99
Chardonnay Soldiers Block 2008 <i>A perfectly balanced wine displaying ripe fruit flavours with a clean crisp finish.</i>	£13.50
Pinot Grigio Norfolk Rise 2008 <i>A slightly pink colour from leaving the juice on the skins for 14 days, excellent flavour with a dry finish.</i>	£14.99

## AUSTRALIAN RED

Cabernet/Merlot Jarrah Ridge 2008 <i>Great value smooth red, good fruit with some weight, drinking well.</i>	£12.25
Shiraz Soldiers Block 2006 <i>A young, fresh and exciting wine bursting with spicy curranty fruit.</i>	£12.99
Merlot Foundstone 2007/8 <i>A rich, full-bodied wine displaying intense black fruit flavours, robust tannins and a warm alcohol finish.</i>	£13.50
Cabernet Sauvignon Norfolk Rise 2005/6 <i>From Mount Benson, 2km. From the Ocean producing a serious smooth red full of blackcurrant fruit, rated 93 by James Halliday.</i>	£15.50

## NEW ZEALAND WHITE

Ana Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2009 <i>Another classic New Zealand Sauvignon from Marlborough (name after the proprietors first Grandchild). Ripe fruits on the nose continue onto the palate but not, as so many can be, too "fruit cocktail", this has a more European flavour.</i>	£14.99
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## NEW ZEALAND RED

Eradus Pinot Noir, Marlborough 2008 <i>The hand-picked grapes in this wine were traditionally fermented and matured in French Oak barrels. The bouquet displays delicious black cherry and chocolate/savoury characteristics. Soft and rich on the palate – a very fine New Zealand Pinot Noir.</i>	£18.99
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## ARGENTINIAN/CHILIAN WHITE

Chardonnay, Santa Florentina (Organic and Fairtrade) 2009 <i>An unoaked organically produced wine also with "fair-trade" status. For Chardonnay lovers who love the fruit and not the oak. Surprisingly, a great aperitif.</i>	£11.99
Chardonnay Andes Peak 2008 <i>Smooth easy drinking Chardonnay, no oak full taste.</i>	£12.99
Sauvignon Blanc Tierra Antica 2008 <i>Well balanced wine with gooseberry and slight pear drop flavour.</i>	£12.99

## ARGENTINIAN/CHILIAN RED

Merlot Andes Peak 2008 <i>This fruity red wine from Chile has soft plummy fruit flavours and is very easy to drink.</i>	£12.50
Cabernet Sauvignon Tierra Antica 2007 <i>Big Chilean red with loads of blackcurrant and a long finish.</i>	£12.50
Malbec Rincon Privado 2007/8 <i>Full on meaty red which will go well with casseroles and hearty dishes.</i>	£12.99

Essensia Orange Muscat 37.5cl. Quady 2006/7 £16.50  
*Dick Quady maybe an eccentric Californian but he produces great wines.*

Monbazillac Dom. De Grange Neuve 50cl. 2005 £16.99  
*From the heart of Bergerac, late picked Semillon, luscious with a clean finish.*

## SPARKLING WINES AND CHAMPAGNE

Louis Perdrier Brut N.V. £13.90  
*Very well made sparkler from the Loire valley in France.*

Louise Perdrier Rosè N.V. £14.50  
*Great little rose, really good flavour – just the thing for summer parties.*

Prosecco Frizzante Spago N.V. £14.50  
*Fresh clean gently sparkling wine from Italy.*

Great Western Brut N.V. Australia £14.50  
*The Aussies are good at this easy drinking with no hard edges.*

Blanc de Blancs, Corney and Barrow £16.75  
*Produced in the same way as champagne from the Savoie region of France –  
Varichon et Clerc have been specialists in sparkling wine for over  
100 years. Dry but not bone dry.*

Cremant de de Bourgogne Rosé, Louis Boillot, N.V. Corney and Barrow £23.99  
*This is an outstanding example of Cremant de Bourgogne, made from 100% Pinot  
Noir with terrific colour, wonderful fruit and great flavour. Superb for parties,  
small or large, as well as being excellent as an aperitif or of course with your meal.*

House Champagne. £27.50  
*Exceptionally high quality, with plenty of fruit and a very forward style. Perfect as an  
aperitif with its fine mousse and delicate palate*
