Archery

This is set in the 250 acre estate surrounded by woodland and life-size as well as moving targets are used. Guests will use traditional bows and arrows.

Clay Shooting

The original country pursuit, and always enjoyed. Special light-weight guns are provided for those that prefer to use them. Our experienced instructors can turn any novice into a crack shot!

4x4 Driving

Guests have to negotiate our specially designed Jungle track in the woods with deep water splashes and steep hills. This is an exhilarating activity and will test your skill and driving knowledge to the maximum.

Air Pistol Shooting

Guests are taught how to fire air pistols at our specially designed target range in the woods.

Rage Buggies

These are large grass go-carts at the heart of which is a robust Honda V-Twin petrol engine, giving strong performance from its 620cc capacity. Guests do timed laps around our obstacle course and the team with the best time wins!

Fly Fishing

We have three beautiful trout lakes, one of which will have been specially stocked for your party. All trout caught are prepared by the instructors for guests to take home in an oven ready or barbeque condition.
